	 Footpaths Rights of Way across the village are difficult to access due to overgrown hedges and grass encroachment. These issues will be reported to NCC. More bins - especially for dog-waste - should be provided with possible sites at Chapel Lane/Church Lane/ High Street/Brewery Lane: Clerk to correspond with District Council enquiring that these bins would be emptied regularly. Comment was made that the problem is not the lack of bins but the behaviour of dog-walkers who do not use the bins already provided.=

Mr Foster signed the acceptance of office form and was invited to join the meeting. Forms will be sent by the Clerk and BDC Electoral Services will be informed.

1510	Recording of Meeting No intentions to record the meeting were received.				
1511	Approval of Minutes The minutes of the meeting held on 8 April 2024, had been circulated. Issues as to how and when challenges to minutes and additions should be made. The use of named voters was challenged at the meeting and guidance was given by Cllr Taylor that it was unusual to record votes by name, and that councillors would not be held individually liable for decisions made by council. Individual councillors could request that their own voting should be recorded. Further guidance was being sought via NALC.				

EVERTON PARISH COUNCIL 1512 Updates on Highways, Footpaths and Public Rights of Way. These matters were discussed earlier in the Public Meeting. There could be more regular mowing of Middle Cross Lane. A price for this extra work would be sought. Residents of the village could report other areas that need to be addressed via the NCC App. 'MyNotts - Highways'. 1513 **Matters for Consideration:** 1. Annual Review of Policies to be undertaken with the Clerk. 2. Review of Roles and Responsibilities. Councillors were asked to read these again and bring any changes or additions to the next meeting. One amendment offered. 3. Consider Donation Requests: a. Windy Ridge Bird Sanctuary - more information required about the nature and status of the organisation and the application referenced against the policy. b. Metcalfe Recreation Committee - this is a general request for funding to support activities for 24/25. Granting such a "general" request recognises the MRC role in Everton as the 'umbrella' organisation which supports and coordinates the local organisations that use the MT facilities. Further project information was requested if available. The PC donations policy welcomes specific feedback on project and initiatives this funding supported, ideally at the APM. Requests for 24/25 funding will be reviewed when the closing date for applications has passed. 4. Insurance Policy schedule had been circulated was discussed and accepted. Details to be confirmed with the Clerk who will advise. 5. Lamp-post Poppies issue to be discussed with RBL. 6. Best Kept Village competition: this will be deferred to 2025. 7.
